Workforce & Training

Defense contractors in the Columbus Region have access to a highly skilled workforce of former military personnel ready for virtually all defense related areas. Approximately 13,000 military personnel and their spouses exit Fort Benning each year, providing a well-trained and talented pool of employees.

The Columbus Region is also home to the Research and Development Center for the Armor, Cavalry and Infantry force, which is linked academically with Auburn University, Columbus State University, the University of Georgia and Georgia Tech. Students at Columbus State University have access to modeling and simulation as well as robotics courses for prospective defense contractor employees. Additionally, the Defense Technology program at Georgia Tech provides certification in nine defense technology areas, including modeling and simulation.

Defense contractors also have access to Georgia's Quick Start workforce training program through Columbus Technical College, giving qualified new and expanding defense-related companies free, comprehensive workforce solutions.
